## **Pre-arrival**





- · Have COVID-19 health insurance with a minimum coverage of US\$100.000;
- Come from countries with a low to medium risk, as announced by the Ministry of Public Health;
- · Have a vaccine certificate to proof that they are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 no less than 14 days before the travel date;
- Register through www.entrythailand.go.th.

















## Arrival



- Undergo Immigration and Customs procedures, and a COVID-19 screening, including RT-PCR tests;
- Install the "Thailand Plus" application and other apps as specified by the province;
- Check in at a pre-booked SHA Plus-certified accommodation establishment for Phuket, and ALQ for Koh Samui, Koh Phangan, and Koh Tao.

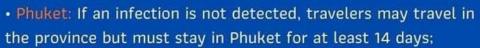

## Stay



Days 1-3 of arrival: Able to leave the room and use

the services at the accommodation:

Days 4-7 of arrival: Travel in a closed system along

specified routes;

Days 8-15 of arrival: Travel in the island.

Additionally, travelers must undergo a COVID-19 test using an RT-PCR method on days 6-7 and 12-13 of their arrival as per the Ministry of Public Health's guidelines.
